## Short-Term Ministry Opportunities With Africa Inland Mission

### Home School Teacher/Helper

Serve a Missionary Family.  
Impact a Community.

Many missionary families live in remote locations where sending their children to a local school often isn't an option. Families want to stay together as they create special bonds while they integrate into their communities. Parents struggle to find a balance between devoting enough time for their children's education and meeting the demands of full time ministry. By helping with the homeschooling, you would be enabling the missionaries to do what they came to do: focus on sharing the Gospel with the unreached and mobilizing the church.



### The Assignment...

#### What will I do?

Families will already have an education plan for their children and will have many of the resources needed. Depending on the situation, you may be teaching the lessons yourself, or be helping a parent implement lessons.

Since home school only runs for part of the day, you will have opportunities to explore and experience cross-cultural life. This could include involvement in the parents' ministry, a local church, and language learning.

#### Who can serve?

Though some locations require qualified teachers, others are willing to take those with other children's ministry experience.

#### How long will I serve?

6-12 months
